With our brand new signs, informative brochures and pledge cards, TKM began to call on patrons of 7-Eleven to cease and desist their patronage until the stores stop selling pornography. Thankfully, many of the patrons responded positively to our request to take information and many even got back in their cars and went across the street to the more family friendly Wawa. The second initiative was the conclusion of our \$10 for \$10,000 raffle fundraiser. This raffle proved to be TKM's most successful fundraising event to date. On Friday November 30th, approximately 100 TKM supporters gathered at the Morgandale Clubhouse in Lansdale for an evening of great food and fellowship all in an effort to help TKM continue the work that we have begun. The night featured a silent auction along with a drawing of a variety of holiday gift baskets. The evening culminated in the drawing of the first prize of \$10,000. The lucky winner was Kevin Kulik of Massapequa, NY. The second prize of \$1,000 went to Sean & Kelly Hodson of Panama City, FL. And the third prize, a TKM gift basket, went to Jean McAfee of Horsham, PA.
